- Have regular meetings and check-ins with your manager
- Help iAngel better understand university's culture and environment

- Ability to work independently and time manage well
- Entrepreneurial attitude – Can work effectively in a resource-constrained, fast pace environment in accordance to iAngel's company culture
- Excellent communication skills
- Self-motivated and goal-oriented
- Stellar networking skills and the ability to reach out to new organizations and resources

- Prior experience in counseling and leading students preferred
- Social science, business, and/or English majors preferred
